TO: ALL HOLDERS OF WARRANTS TO SUBSCRIBE FOR NEW ORDINARY SHARES IN THE CAPITAL OF DAYEN ENVIRONMENTAL LTD. (THE "COMPANY")

PROCEDURE FOR EXERCISE OF WARRANTS

Completed Exercise Notice must be delivered to the Warrant Agent not later than **5.00 p.m. on Friday, 3 July 2009** accompanied by the following:

1. A remittance (in Singapore currency) by banker's draft or by cashier's order drawn on a bank in Singapore made payable to "**DAYEN ENVIRONMENTAL LTD**" for the full amount of the aggregate Exercise Price payable in respect of the Warrants exercised. The name of the exercising Warranholder, the number of Warrants being exercised and the securities account number of the exercising Warranholder from which the number of Warrants being exercised is to be debited should

be clearly written on the reverse side of the banker's draft or cashier's order, as the case may be;

AFTER THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS AT 5.00 P.M. ON 3 JULY 2009, ANY SUBSCRIPTION RIGHTS UNDER THE WARRANTS WHICH HAVE NOT BEEN EXERCISED AS AFORESAID WILL LAPSE AND EVERY WARRANT WILL THEREAFTER CEASE TO BE VALID FOR ANY PURPOSE WHATSOEVER.
